Mr. Plante serves on the editorial advisory board of the Palm Springs Desert Sun and reports for NBC Palm Springs. He is a Peabody and Emmy award winner whose career spans three decades, including work in Los Angeles and in San Francisco, where, as one of the first openly gay news anchors, his reporting on the AIDS epidemic earned national accolades.

The program will guide participants through the process of developing compelling news stories, including the analysis of stories to realize their maximum potential, writing for video, finding the right voice for your story, and developing techniques which make that story stand out. The tips and tools provided have value well beyond news; Mr. Plante's insights apply equally well to documentary production and all forms of non-fiction writing. The program will also feature an extensive, Q&A session, which will enable participants to address their own specific project issues and concerns.
